#### **Church Membership - Why Membership and What Is Expected?**

Why This Article

Okay, this bulletin article is probably long overdue and it has probably also been expected for some time now.

Church membership is an important issue. And it has been a thorny issue for our church because of our history.

This article is meant to encourage those who are intending to become members. And it's also meant to encourage those who are yet undecided. And it's also meant to plead with those who may be averse to becoming church members.

It's not the intention of this article to bully anyone into church membership, nor is it to meant to make members feel guilty.

But hopefully the reasons contained here would help you to think about your commitment to the body of Christ, especially this local congregation that you have been attending.

With effect from 6 May 2015, the Department of Commerce has accepted the changes to our constitution.

This means that Christians may become members, who may not completely agree with the Westminster standards, but have a teachable and humble spirit, and desire to covenant with us.

The Importance of Church Membership

And it is important to be members of a local church. Not only is it important, it is commanded.

Christians are to meet often with one another to encourage one another in the faith.

Hebrews 10:24-25 says, "And let us consider one another to provoke unto

love and to good works: Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some is; but exhorting one another: and so much the more, as ye see the day approaching."

Such mutual ministry can only take place in the context of a local body of believers. In other words, we are to identify ourselves with God's covenant people.

Can this be accomplished without formally being part of a local church? It cannot.

The reason for this is God also commands accountability. There are instructions for Christians to submit to the leaders of the church (1 Thessalonians 5:12-13) and for the leaders to watch over the souls of the Christians (Hebrews 13:7).

This cannot be done unless there is a covenant that exists to obligate the officers and worshipers of the church to one another.

Membership is also essential in having an orderly church. We are told by Paul that all things should be done properly and orderly (1 Corinthians 14:40).

Eric Lane, in his book Members of One Another, writes, "The church is likened in the Bible sometimes to a body, sometimes to a family or household sometimes to a kingdom, sometimes to an army. For any of these organisms to function properly, order of some kind is required. The same applies to the church. The church is not just a loose collection of individuals, it is a closely knit structure like a human body (Eph 4:16) and has therefore to be rightly organized. For such ordering it

needs to know exactly who belongs to it. A family which sat down to its mealtable or locked its doors at night, not knowing who was supposed to be there and who not, would be an extremely strange phenomenon. An army battalion which did not know whom to expect on parade would soon be in chaos. If the church is to be a true family and an effective fighting force it needs to know who exactly belongs to it."

This is the whole purpose of having membership in a local church.

#### **Duties of Members**

And if you are a member, this is what is expected of you. You are to attend church regularly. Nothing should hinder your weekly attendance but sickness or the works of necessity and mercy. Worship is your most basic duty to God (Psalm 100:2,3).

There are also ministries that you can be involved in, where you are served by others, and where you can serve others.

The prayer meeting of the church is an important ministry. Take time to pray for

the brethren - those who are sick and those who have needs.

Remember that as a church member you are part of a family and therefore you are responsible to care for other members. And this means taking time to get to know them and their needs, and including them in your prayers.

#### Conclusion

Many of you have been faithfully attending. You don't live elsewhere. You are not moving elsewhere. If you do, seek membership at a local church.

But since you are here, you have been attending, and there are no serious impediments, why would you not seek membership?

Membership is not a sentimental issue. It is a very practical and biblical issue.

There is a way to behave in the church of God. Being a member is one of them.

1 Timothy 3:15 – "But if I tarry long, that thou mayest know how thou oughtest to behave thyself in the house of God, which is the church of the living God, the pillar and ground of the truth."  $\sim$  Pastor

### Westminster Confession of Faith XXVIII - Of Baptism

- 1. Baptism is a sacrament of the New Testament, ordained by Jesus Christ,¹ not only for the solemn admission of the party baptized into the visible Church;² but also to be unto him a sign and seal of the covenant of grace,³ of his ingrafting into Christ,⁴ of regeneration,⁵ of remission of sins,⁶ and of his giving up unto God, through Jesus Christ, to walk in the newness of life.⁻ Which sacrament is, by Christ's own appointment, to be continued in His Church until the end of the world.<sup>8</sup>
