Points To Ponder

1. What really wicked and dangerous thing do you want to see removed and transported?
2. Is there an importance that the basket is an *ephah*, a measuring unit equal to about 3 or 4 buckets?
3. This basket contains wickedness or iniquity. Why does it go forth through the land? Why is wickedness like leaven?
4. Wickedness is portrayed by a woman in this vision. A lead disc keeps her head down inside the basket. How should we press down on our evils and *put a lid* on them?
5. Nuclear waste is dangerous, dangerous to store. Where does one take it? Where do the 2 women take the wickedness of God's people?
6. What does 'Shinar' stand for? How and when will Jesus deal with the wickedness of mankind?
